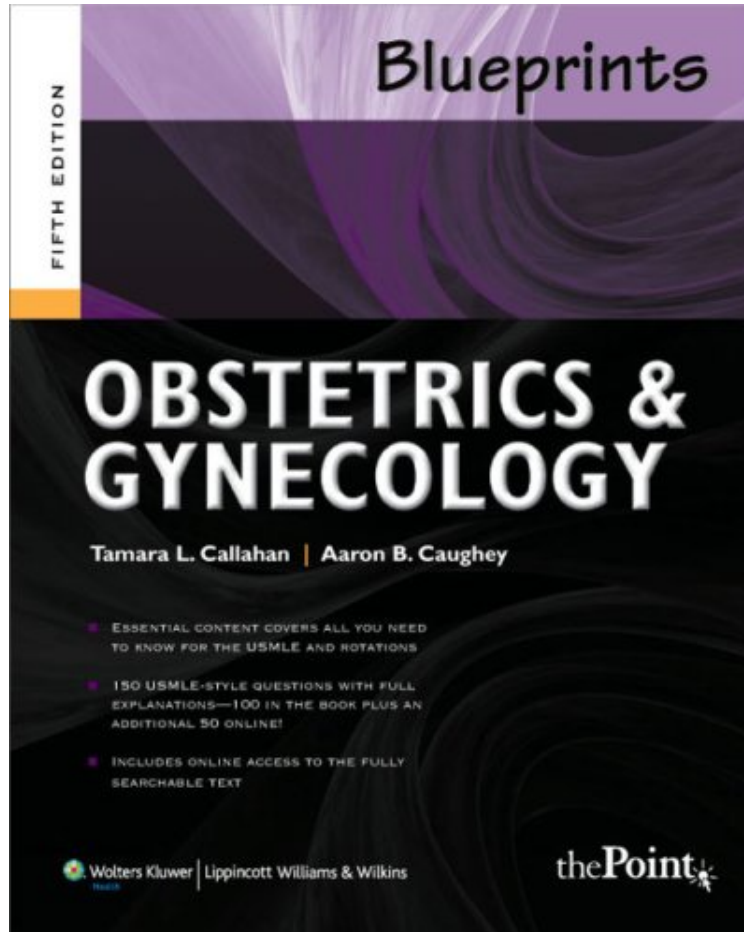

The book is clinically oriented and complete. It is divided into two major sections. Half of the book is ob and the second half is gyn. I felt that it provided all the important information I needed for the exam. It is also a great reference to keep around to look up random ob-gyn questions you may have.The book also has important words in bold print. This is very helpful when studying to draw the eye in for a closer look. There is also a practice exam in the back of the book which was an excellent review before the exam. Addendum I came back to edit this review after completing my OB/GYN Clerkship and Shelf exam. This book is great for building a foundation to understand women's health issues BUT the questions contained at the end of the book are NOT sufficient to do well on the shelf exam. I recommend ALSO purchasing a question book and doing as many questions as you can.
