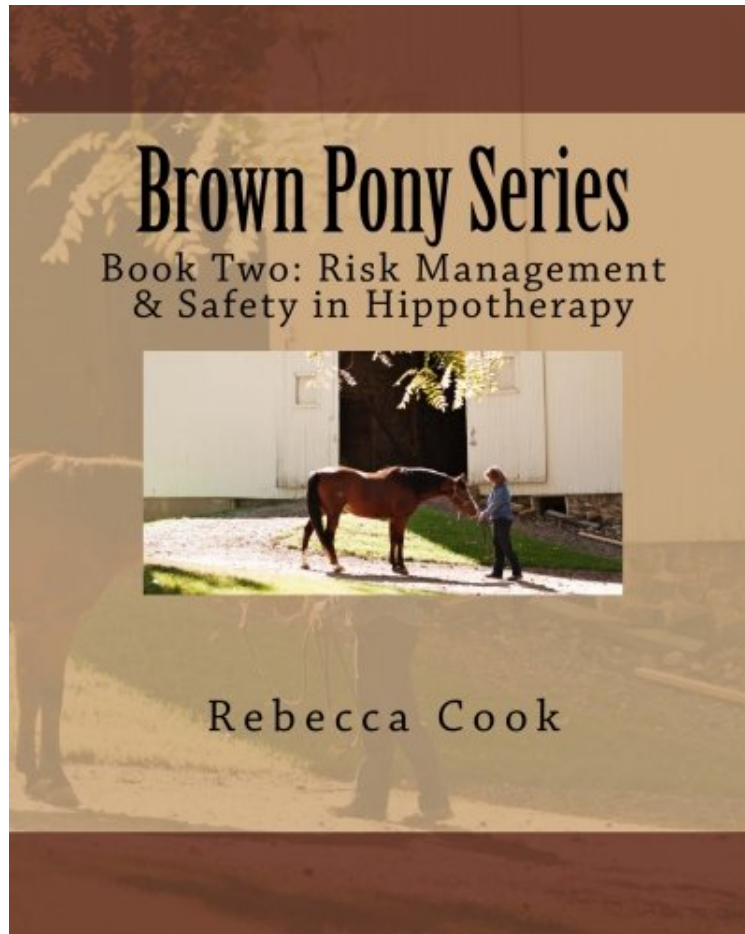

Brown Pony Series Book Two: Risk Management and Safety in Hippotherapy, illuminates years of research both published and unpublished that has been completed by the author on safety and managing risks when combining horses and people with disabilities in a therapy milieu. NOTE: The Hippotherapy Safety Survey ended ten years of data collection in January of 2017. This book was updated on September 1, 2017 with a summary of the ten years of safety data in a newly added Appendix II.
