However, as a reference to use while reading medical literature it is quite frustrating. There is no way to go quickly to the main entry for a given term. Instead, you have to search for the term and then slog through an often long list of every appearance of that term in this very long book, a very slow process on both my paper White and iPad. I should have got the hardcover version.
