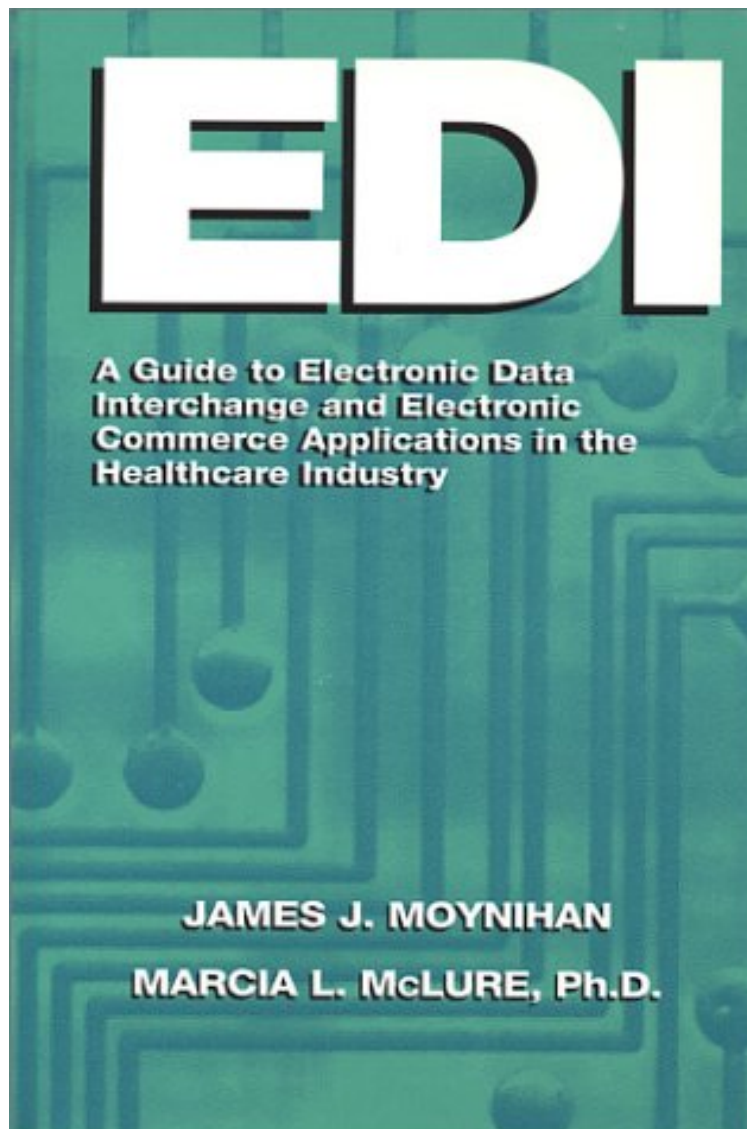

First of all, this book is overpriced. 45 dollars for 155 pages of actual book text (minus the index, etc) is ridiculous. Yes, I saw that it was a small book in the description, but I hoped that the content would be dense and useful...it was not. This book was copyrighted in 2001, yet there isn't even a mention of HIPAA or ASCA. This book is best described as an advertisement for the use of EDI. It rambles on on about how great EDI is (yes, we know that) but never gets into any meat about standards, communications, formats, etc. Save your 45 bucks...it would be better spent on beer...
