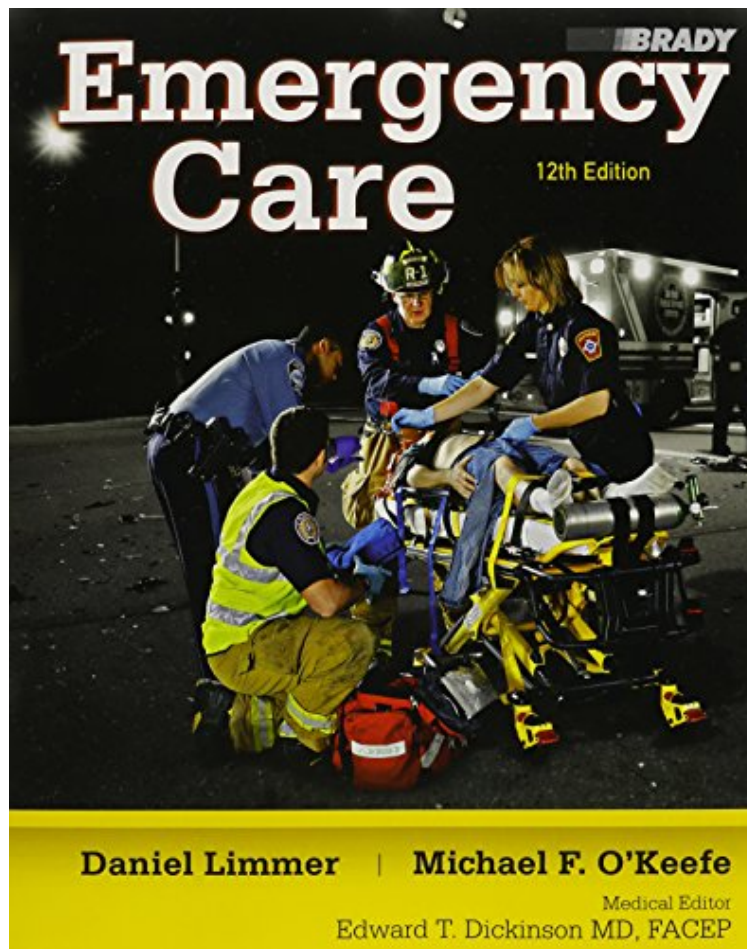

Dr. Dickinson has remained active in fire service and EMS for the past 25 years. He frequently rides with EMS units and has maintained his certification as a National Registry EMT-Paramedic. He has served as medical editor for numerous Brady EMT -B and First Responder texts and is the author of "Fire Service Emergency Care," and co-author of Emergency Care-Fire Services Edition, EMT-B textbooks. "Michael A. Wieder, MS, CFPS, MIFireE," is the Assistant Director at Fire Protection Publications, headquarters for the International Fire Service Training Association (IFSTA), at Oklahoma State University in Stillwater, Oklahoma.
