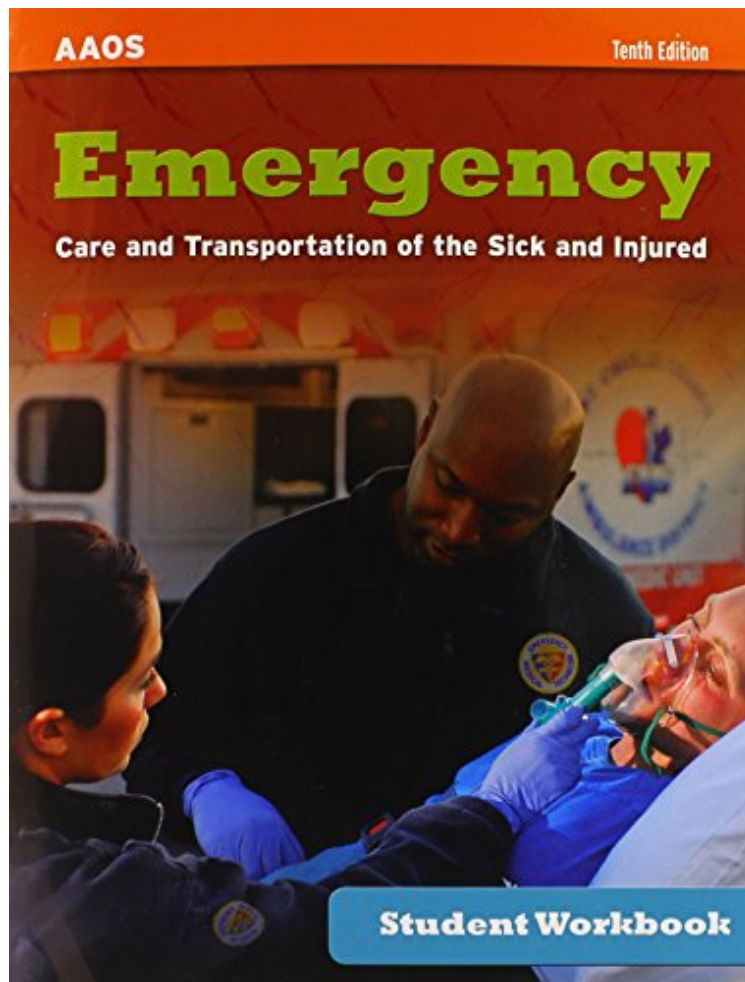

That being said the content is very thorough and easy to understand By IeshaT8875 This book is heavily repetitive, often recycling several pages of information throughout the chapters, which could be beneficial for classes which skip chapters or review chapters out of order but given the nature of most EMT programs I hope that is not the case. The book also introduces several procedures and techniques in the early chapters and makes no attempt to define or explain them until further chapters. That being said the content is very thorough and easy to understand.
