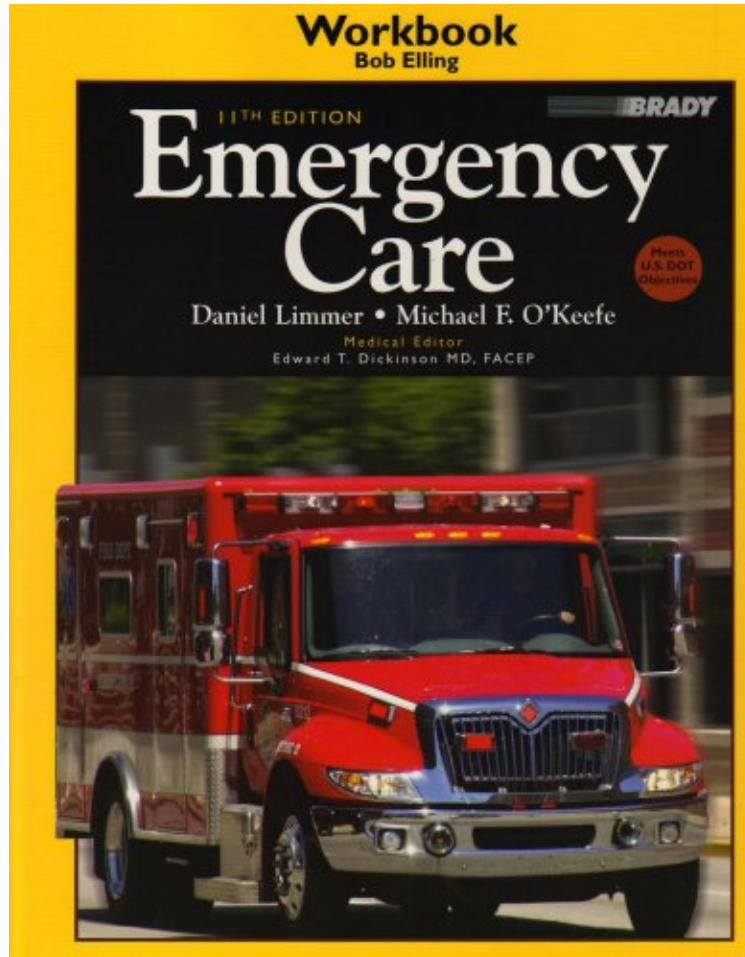

An important distinction to make is haphazard does not mean incomplete, it means that searching for information about a subject when the key terms are not intuitive is very hard. For example, terms and concepts related to perfusion is dispersed throughout the book in separate topics, each one

only giving a piece of the puzzle of what perfusion is, details, and how it goes wrong. So understanding perfusion by looking at a particular section is not possible.
