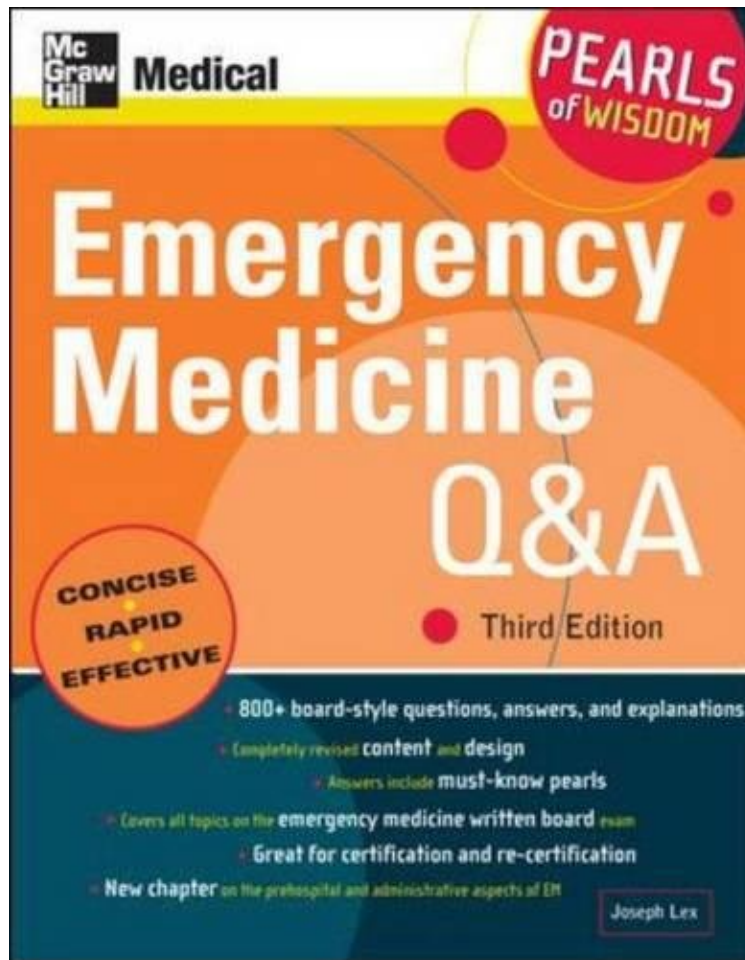

The questions are low yield and in many cases first order questions which do not prepare you for either test. Quite a few test obscure details irrelevant to emergency medicine, and unlike the 1000 questions book the answers are very brief and do not explain why the wrong answers are wrong. Don't waste your money - or more importantly valuable review time - on this.The only good thing that can be said is that the book has answers immediately following the questions so you don't have to flip back and forth to read them between questions.
