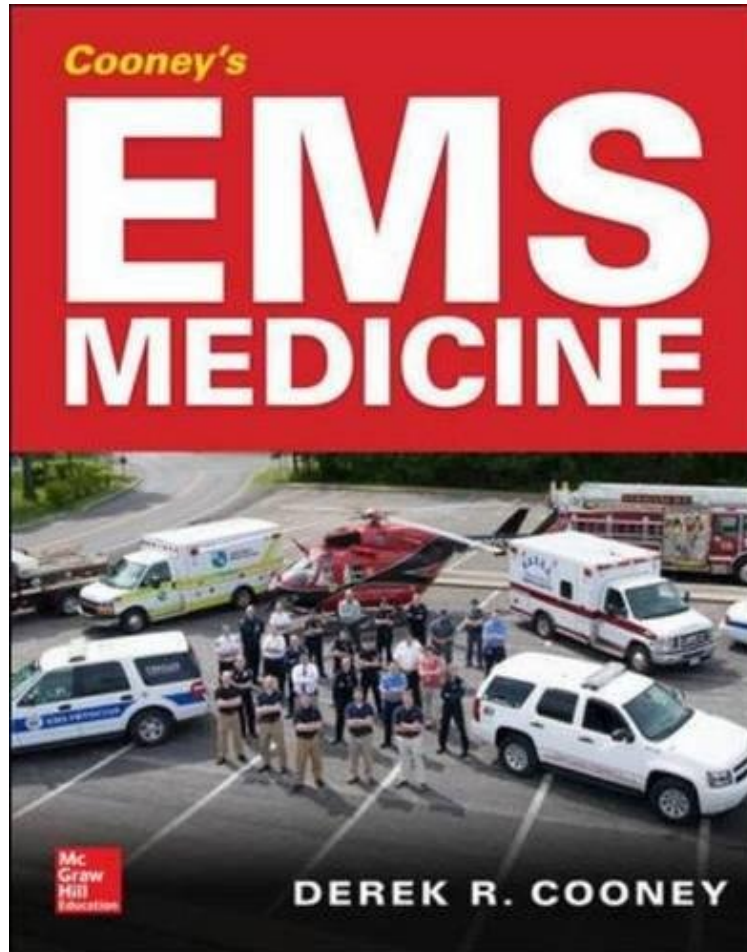

It is meant specifically for Emergency Medicine physicians training to work in the field of Prehospital (EMS) Medicine. In particular, this book is meant for EMS fellows and is NOT for Paramedics, EMTs, etc. Based on what I have read of the ACGME requirements and the book itself, I think this book does an excellent job of covering the core content prescribed by ACGME for EMS fellows. It is split roughly into 50% clinical (medical trauma), 25% operations (field business), and 25% introduction to prehospital medicine EMS. It is nice in that it is only about 2/3 the length of Cone's Emergency Medical Services: Clinical Practice and Systems Oversight, which is the official textbook for the NAEMSP EMS Medical Director course. Thus, for someone reviewing for the boards, this would likely be a better book. In addition, I would recommend this text as an excellent textbook for an EMS Medicine elective targeted at advanced medical students or

residents in EM or FM.
